RIIWHS204D WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS

OBJECTIVE

This course is designed to provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to work safely at heights in the workplace.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The course will cover working safely at heights in resources and infrastructure industries. It includes identifying the work requirements, work procedures and instructions for the task; identifying fall hazards, accessing and installing equipment; performing work at heights; and cleaning up the work area.

PRE-REQUISITE

There are no pre-requisite units for this course. However it is recommended that participants have no fear of heights.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

As a result of this program, participants will be able to:

- · Identify work and OSH requirements associated with working safely at heights
- · Identify, manage and report potential risks and hazards associated with working at heights
- · Select and check safety equipment
- Inspect and/or install fall protection and perimeter protection equipment
- Ensure correct fitting, adjustment and anchor placement for fall protection equipment
- Establish safe access to work area, correct manual handling procedures and placement of tools and materials at heights
- · Safely dismantle, inspect and store work at height safety system
- Use basic rescue equipment.
